S/SY: COMMUNITY GUIDELINES

SASY believes in your capacity to create positive changes in your life. To support this, SASY provides a safe, holistic learning environment where you can explore who you are and discover your potential. It is important for you to do your part in maintaining this inclusive community.

AT SASY, WE ASK YOU TO:

- **Communicate respectfully:** use appropriate language towards others and engage in respectful conversations, to ensure SASY is a safe and supportive place for everyone.
- **Protect everyone's privacy:** for everyone's safety, do not film, record, or photograph anyone without their permission.
- **3** Celebrate diversity and inclusion: be respectful and inclusive of everyone's ethnicity, gender, religion, sexual orientation, and perspectives.
- Follow staff directions with understanding: staff are here to support you. If you need to leave a SASY space, please communicate with a staff member so we can make sure you are safe.
- **Respect the space:** take care of SASY spaces and equipment. Treat SASY property with respect and clean up after yourself to maintain a safe and welcoming environment.
- 6 Minimise harm from smoking and vaping: it is illegal to smoke or vape within 10 metres of businesses, including SASY buildings. If you are looking for support around nicotine use, talk to a staff member, we are here to help.
- **7** Use digital tools safely and legally: taking, sending, or sharing inappropriate images (including nudes or sexts) can cause harm, and is illegal if it involves anyone under 18, or is without consent.
- Prioritise health and safety around substances: using drugs or alcohol, including experiencing withdrawal symptoms, can affect your safety. If you are struggling with substances, we encourage you to talk to a Youth Worker. Distributing drugs is illegal and poses serious risks.
- 9 Understand that bullying is not tolerated: bullying causes harm. We are committed to early intervention, support, and education to prevent and respond to bullying behaviours.
- 10 Understand that violence is not tolerated: SASY supports peaceful, restorative ways of managing conflict, and building resilience and understanding.

By signing the SASY Community Guidelines, I agree to help keep our space safe and supportive. I understand that serious or repeated breaches of these guidelines may impact my enrolment at SASY.
